3.1 Definitions

higher layer entity: An abstract entity, typically implemented in software, that resides above the WAVE protocols in the protocol stack, and may make use of WAVE communication services. (IEEE Std 1609.3)

higher layer service: An abstract entity, involving an exchange of data, generally provided by a higher layer entity on one WAVE device to a similar entity on another WAVE device, using WAVE communications. (IEEE Std 1609.3) *Syn:* **service.**

provider: Advertiser of a Wireless Access in Vehicular Environments (WAVE) service. (IEEE Std 1609.3) *See also:* **user, Wireless Access in Vehicular Environments (WAVE) Service Advertisement.**

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
